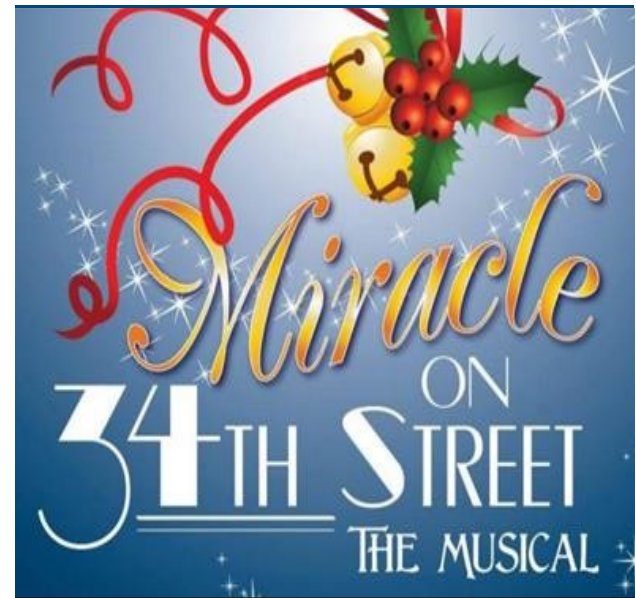
If you miss the bus, it will be at your expense to find us and reach our new destination.

Waiting List: Once a trip is filled to capacity, a waiting list will be created on a first-come basis. When a vacancy becomes available, we will call until a replacement can be found.

Subject to Change: Trip itineraries are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances. If so, acceptable substitutions will be arranged. Every effort will be made to follow scheduled itinerary.

Cancellation: Please contact us as soon as you know that you will need to cancel your reservation on a trip. All monies, will be refunded except any expenses incurred that cannot be recovered, which includes the non refundable deposit.
